

CHARTREUSE & BLUE FLAMETHROWER

Hook – Salar Silver Double
Thread - Black
Rib - Silver wire
Rear Body - Flat Silver Holo
Mid Hackle – Mid Blue cock
Mid Wing – Mid Blue Bucktail
Pearl Krystal Flash

Rib - Silver wire
Front Body – Chartreuse Ice Dub
Hackle – Chartreuse Schlappen
Eyes - Jungle Cock
Head - Pearl



Secure the hook in the vice. Tie in the thread and wind down to the point tying in a length of Medium Silver Wire and a length of Flat Silver Holo. Wind the thread to the midpoint. Wind the Holo up to here forming the rear half of the body. Take 2 close turns of wire at the rear and then rib up to the midpoint. Tie in and trim off. Tie in a Mid Blue cock hackle by the tip, double it and wind 4 turns. The hackle should reach beyond the end of the hook. Take some turns of thread over the base of the hackle to slope it backwards. Prepare a bunch of Mid Blue Bucktail and tie in about twice the hook length. Tie in three strands of Pearl Krystal flash the same length. Take the thread up to head binding everything in and trim off the waste at an angle. Return the thread to the midpoint tying in a length of Silver wire. Dub the thread with Chartreuse Ice Dub. Wind the thread back to the head forming the front body. Rib it with the wire, tie in and trim off the waste. Tie in a Chartreuse Schlappen or Hen hackle by the tip. Double it and wind 3 turns, this hackle should be shorter than the mid hackle. Prepare a pair of Jungle Cock eyes and tie in. Fold back the stalks and bind in tightly, trim off the waste. Form a smooth head. Tie in a length of fine Pearl mylar and slightly stretch it leaving the thread at the eye. Apply a thin coat of superglue to the head and wind the mylar over the head. Apply superglue to 5mm of the thread and take 2 turns to tie in the mylar. Trim off the waste. Coat the head with superglue and when dry apply a coat of nail varnish.
