

## NESS C

Hook - Silver Double  
Thread - #15 Glo Brite floss  
Tag - Oval Silver  
Tail - Yellow, Orange and  
Purple Bucktail  
Orange Krystal Flash  
Rib - Oval Silver  
Rear Body - Flat Pearl Mylar  
Thorax - #15 Glo Brite floss  
Hackle - Yellow Cock  
Orange Badger Cock  
Head - Fire Orange



Secure the hook in the vice. Put the Glo Brite floss in a bobbin holder as this will be used to tie all of the fly apart from the hackle and head. Tie in the floss and wind down to the point tying in a length of Oval Silver. Wind the Oval 4 turns backwards to form a tag, take the Oval between the 2 hooks and pull back towards the head. Secure with the floss and trim off. Prepare small bunches of Orange, Yellow and a pinch of Purple Bucktail. Even up the tips and roll between your fingers to mix them together. Tie this bunch in about twice the hook length, it should be fairly sparse. Tie in 2 strands of micro Orange Krystal flash the same length. Tie in a length of Silver Oval and a length of flat Pearl Lurex tinsel. Wind the floss up three quarters of the shank binding everything in neatly and trim the waste. Coat the body with superglue and then wind the Pearl tinsel up to the this point forming a neat over body, tie in and trim the waste. Rib the body with Silver Oval, tie it in and trim off. Wind the floss up to the head forming a a thorax. Tie in the Fire Orange thread. Trap in the floss with the thread and trim it off. Tie in a Yellow cock hackle by the tip, double it and wind 2 turns. Tie in and trim the waste. Tie in an Orange Badger cock hackle by the tip, double it and wind 2 turns. Tie in and trim the waste. Form a neat small head and whip finish. Give the head a coat of superglue and when dry several coats of thin clear varnish to produce a smooth shiny head.
