

## OLIVIA

Hook – Silver  
Thread – White  
Tag – Silver Oval  
Tail – White cock hackle  
Tail – Pink Bucktail  
Pearl Krystal Flash  
Rib – Silver oval  
Body – Pearl Ice Dub  
Wing – White Bucktail  
Hackle – White cock and Pink badger cock  
Eyes – Jungle Cock  
Head – Pearl



Secure the hook in the vice. Tie in the thread and wind down to the bend tying in a length of Oval Silver. Wind the Oval 4 turns backwards to form a tag, take the Oval between the 2 hooks and pull back towards the head. Secure with the thread and trim off. Tie in a long fibred White cock hackle by the tip. Double it, wind 4 turns and tie in. Prepare and tie in a bunch of Pink Bucktail. The tail should be at least twice the shank length. Tie in 3 strands of Pearl Krystal Flash. Take the thread to the head binding everything in and trim the waste. Return the thread to the tail tying in a length of Silver Oval as you go down. Wax the thread and dub it with Pearl Ice Dub, or Lite Brite. Wind up to the head forming the body. Rib with the Oval, tie in and trim off. Prepare and tie in a small bunch of White Bucktail for the wing, this should be shorter than the tail length. Trim the waste at a taper and bind in tightly. Tie in a White cock hackle by the tip. Double it and wind 3 turns, tie in and trim the waste. Tie in a dyed Pink Badger cock hackle by the tip, double it and wind 3 turns. Tie in tightly and trim the waste. Take some turns of thread tight up to the base to slope it backwards. Prepare and tie in a pair of Jungle Cock eyes, pull back the waste stalks, bind in tightly and trim the waste. Form a neat head tying in a length of fine Pearl mylar leaving the thread at the eye. Apply a thin coat of superglue to the head and wind the mylar over the head. Apply superglue to 5mm of the thread and take 2 turns to tie in the mylar. Trim off the waste. Coat the head with superglue and when dry apply a coat of nail varnish.
