

THUNDER DUCK

Tube – Gold glitter with clear inner

Tag – Gold oval

Tail – Yellow Polar Bear

Rib – Gold Wire

Rear body – Black floss

Front Body – Black Polar Dub

Hackle – Hot Orange cock palmered

Wing 1 – Hot Orange Polar Bear

Wing 2 – Hot Orange Tanuki, Gold Angel Hair, Fiery Brown Marble Fox

Topping – Yellow Krystal Flash Horns – Blue Krystal Flash

Eyes – Jungle Cock Front Hackle – Dyed Blue Mallard

Head – Gold Eumer cone



Prepare a Gold Glitter outer with clear inner tube. Tie in the thread on the outer tube and wind down to where the inner tube finishes tying in a length of Gold Oval. Wind the Oval forward 3 turns to form a tag, tie in and trim off. Prepare a bunch of Yellow Polar Bear and tie in for the tail, about the same length as the tube. Tie in a length of Gold Wire and a length of Black floss. Take the thread up to the midpoint binding everything down and trim off the waste ends. Wind the floss up to here to form the rear body, tie in and trim off. Dub the thread with Black Polar Dub and wind to the head forming the front body. Tie in a short fibred Hot Orange cock hackle by the base. Wind 2 close turns at the head and the palmer over the front body. Hold the hackle tip taught and rib the Wire up securing the hackle. Tie in and trim off at both ends. Take the thread onto the liner tubing and form a bed of waxed thread. Prepare and tie in a small bunch of Orange Polar Bear for the 1st wing, slightly shorter than the tail. Tie in a bunch of Orange Tanuki, some strands of Gold Angel Hair and a final layer of Fiery Brown Fox for the wing, each layer should be longer than the one below. Trim the waste and bind down tightly. Tie in 4 strands of Yellow Flash over the wing and 2 strands of Blue Flash along each side of the wing. Tie in a dyed Blue Mallard hackle by the tip, double it and wind 2 turns, tie in and trim the waste. Form a small head and whip finish.

Slip the cone onto the tubing cut the liner sticking out the front to 2mm.

Gently apply a flame to the tube and melt over the end until it is flush with the head to fix the cone.
