

YOKANGA GOLD

Hook - Gold Double
Tag - Gold Oval
Tail - Sunburst Arctic Fox
Rib - Gold Wire
Body - Holo Gold Tinsel
Wing - Flame Arctic Fox
Gold Krystal Flash
Hackle - Hot Orange Cock
Wing - Black Arctic Runner
Eyes - Jungle Cock



Secure the hook in the vice. Tie in the thread and wind down to the point tying in a length of Oval Gold. Wind the Oval 4 turns backwards to form a tag, take the Oval between the 2 hooks and pull back towards the head. Secure with the thread and trim off. Prepare a bunch of Sunburst Arctic Fox which will be a mixture of the longer guard hairs and shorter underfur. Tie in for the tail about the same length as the hook. Tie in a piece of medium Gold wire and a length of large Gold Holo. Take the thread to the head binding everything in and forming a smooth underbody. Trim off the waste. Coat the body with superglue and wind the Holo up to the head forming a nice smooth body and tie in. Rib with the wire in nice even turns, tie in and trim off. Prepare a bunch of Flame Arctic Fox and tie in about the same length as the tail. Flame is made by Hot Orange overdyed with Floro Red, but you can only get this if you dye your own materials so use the hottest Orange you can buy. Tie in four strands of Gold Krystal flash slightly longer, bind in tightly and trim the waste. Tie in a Hot Orange cock hackle by the tip. Double it and wind 4 turns. Take some turns of thread tight up to the base to slope it backwards. The hackle should just reach the hook points. Prepare a bunch of Black Arctic Runner, you can substitute Arctic Fox, and tie in slightly longer than the underwing. Bind in tightly and trim the waste. Prepare a pair of Jungle Cock eyes and tie in on the sides of the wing. Fold back the stalks and bind in tightly. Trim the waste. Form a neat head and whip finish. Now apply several coats of thin clear varnish to produce a smooth shiny head.
